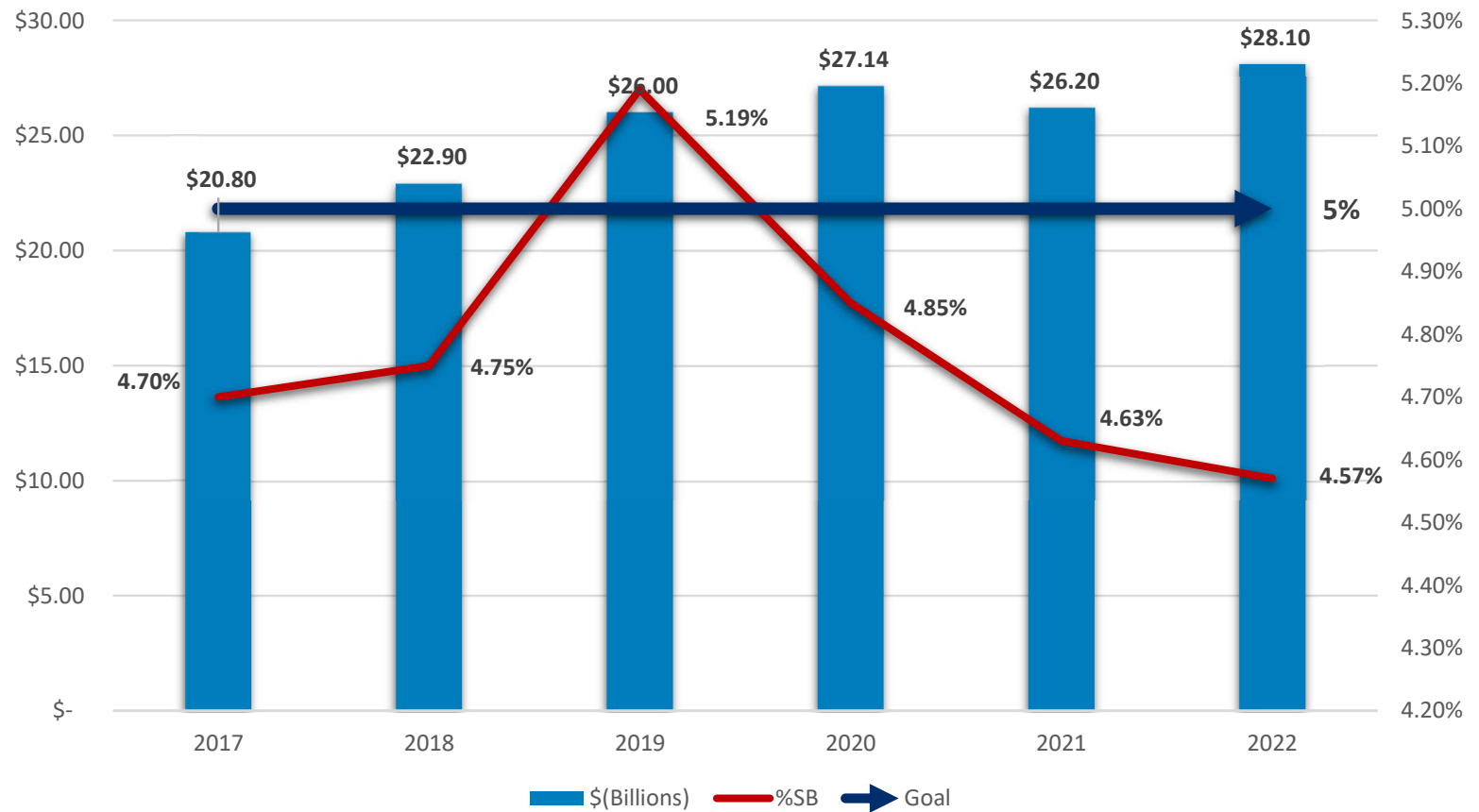

# Unique Aspects of the WOSB Federal Contract Program



Many NAICS codes are now authorized for use under the WOSB Federal Contract Program. Check [sba.gov/wosbready](https://sba.gov/wosbready) for available NAICS (733).



WOSBs and EDWOSB must receive certification through [WOSB.certify.sba.gov](https://wosb.certify.sba.gov) in order to be eligible to compete on set-aside and sole-source contracts.



COs must verify WOSB and EDWOSB certification on the [Dynamic Small Business Search \(DSBS\)](#) database.

# Certification Changes

- The final rule was published in the Federal Register on May 11, 2020. This final rule fully details changes to the certification process and went into effect on October 15, 2020.
- Once the changes went into effect:
  - All WOSBs seeking to participate in the WOSB Federal Contract Program must apply through the SBA's FREE online certification platform or go through an approved third-party entity at a cost. SBA will accept certification from current and active 8(a) or VA CVE/SBA VetCert certified firms.
  - Women-owned small businesses that are not certified for SBA's WOSB Federal Contracting Program may continue to identify as women-owned small businesses in SAM.gov and receive contract awards outside the program, and these awards can count toward an agency's goal for awards to WOSBs.

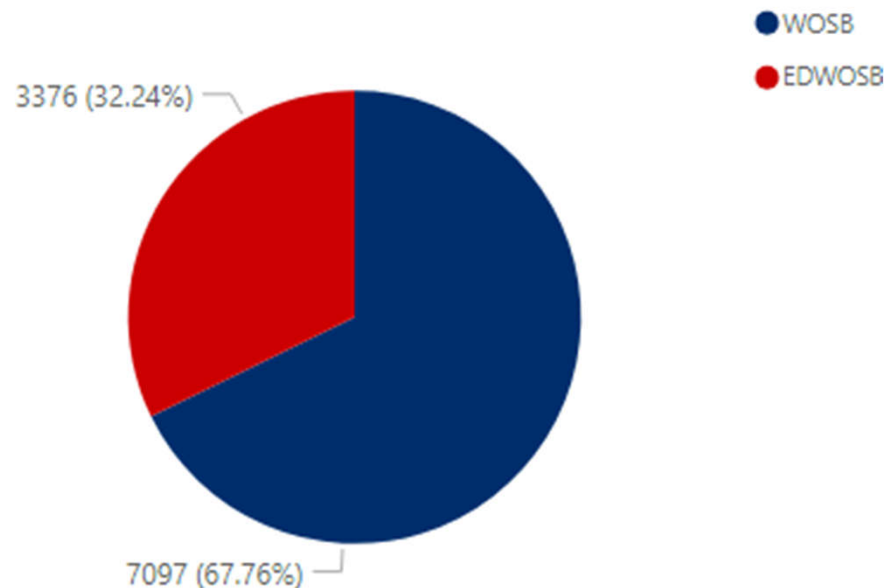

## Good News Stories

- Following training and support by the WOSB Program in March 2023, DHS reported awarding a \$40.9M WOSB set-aside contract for armed protective security services at 7 facilities
- DHS (National Capital Region) reported within a 7-month period awarding \$183M under 4 WOSB set-asides for protective security services in the DC metro area
- Dept of Education creating a WOSB set-aside Digital Services IDIQ, CANDACE – named after Candace Waterman, former CEO for Women Impacting Public Policy (WIPP)
- **Fueling US Economic Impact:** In FY21, over \$1.2 billion in federal procurements were set-aside for WOSB/EDWOSB firms generated 2.8x the impact for a total of over \$3.6 billion in aggregate economic activity—WOSB firms have the biggest impact to our US marketplace more than any of the other SBA set-aside programs.

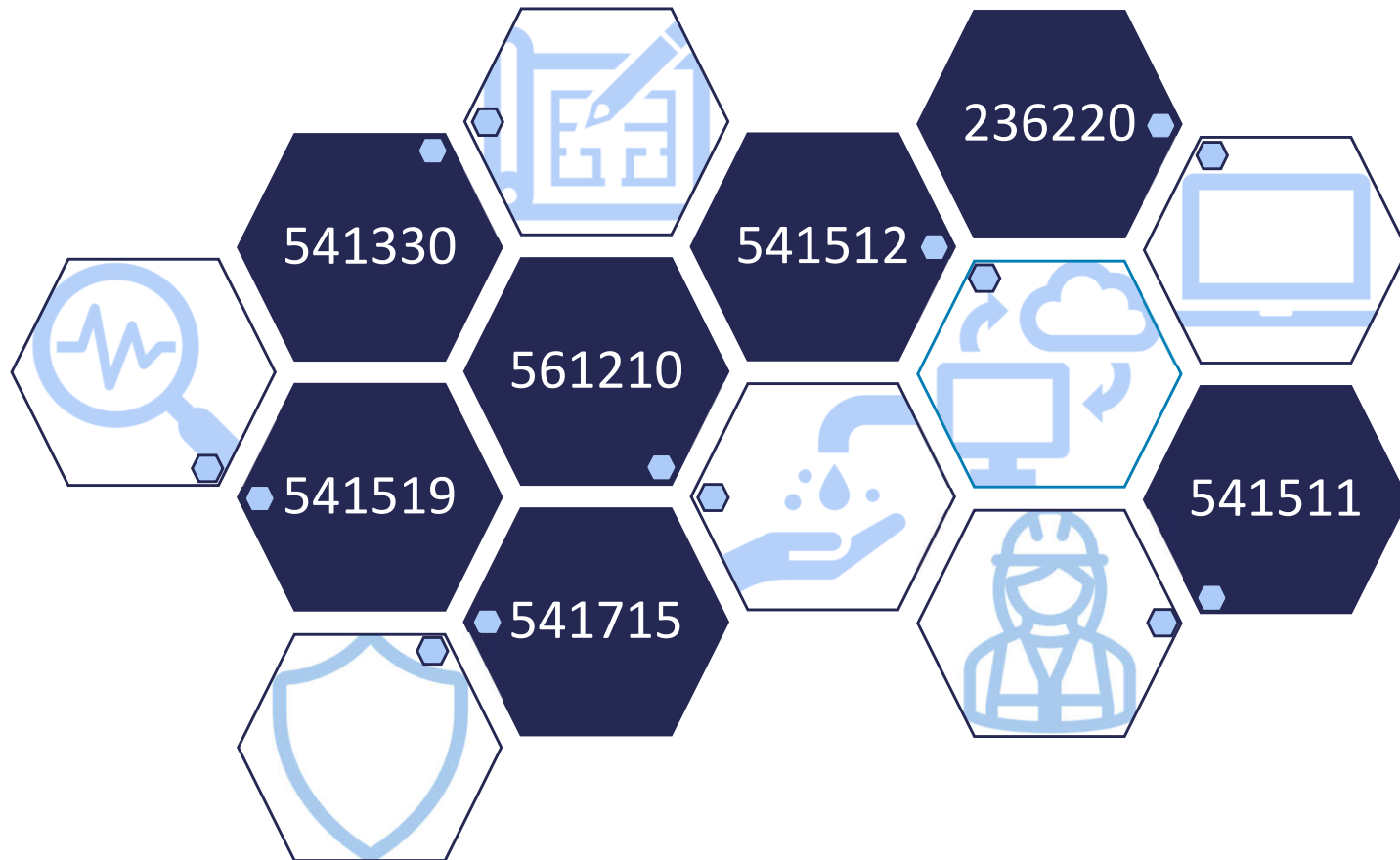

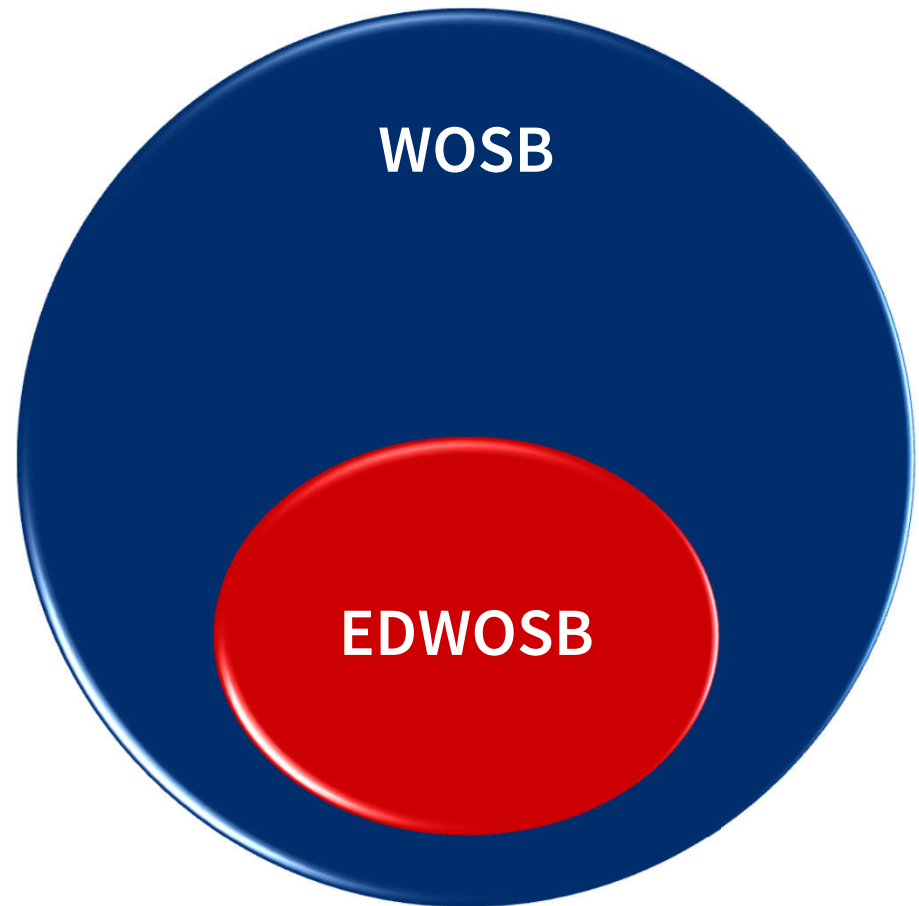
# Myth Busting

- “Sole-source is confusing.”
- “Most WOSBs only do administrative services.”
- “I can’t find WOSBs that sell what we buy.”
- “The pool of participants is not large enough.”
- “Not enough capable WOSB firms to meet our special requirements”
- “Seems too complicated to verify eligibility.”

# WOSBs and EDWOSBs

- **WOSB:** Women-Owned Small Business
- **EDWOSB:** Economically Disadvantaged Women-Owned Small Business; WOSBs whose owner and/or manager claims economic disadvantage

EDWOSB is a subset of WOSB. As such, if you qualify as an EDWOSB, you automatically qualify as a WOSB.

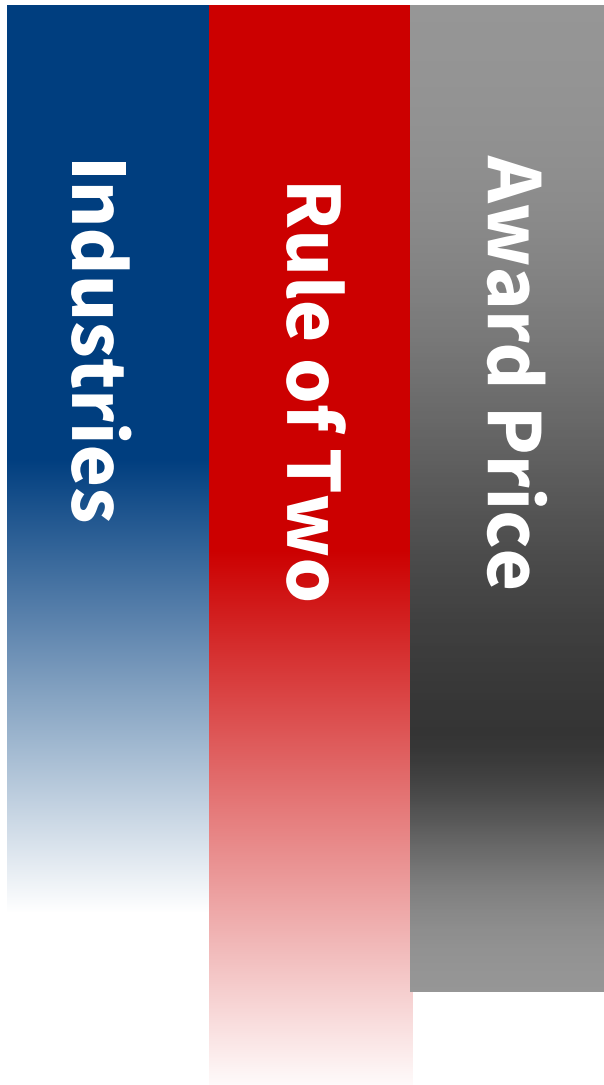

# How to Find a WOSB/EDWOSB Firm

- Search DSBS to find and verify WOSB or EDWOSB -certified businesses.
- Get personal assistance from the SBA's government contracting area offices or from Procurement Technical Assistance Centers.
- Contact your agency's Office of Small and Disadvantaged Business Utilization (OSDBU) or your Agency Small Business Specialist.
- Issue a sources sought announcement in the System for Awards Management (SAM) seeking interested WOSB/EDWOSB small businesses.

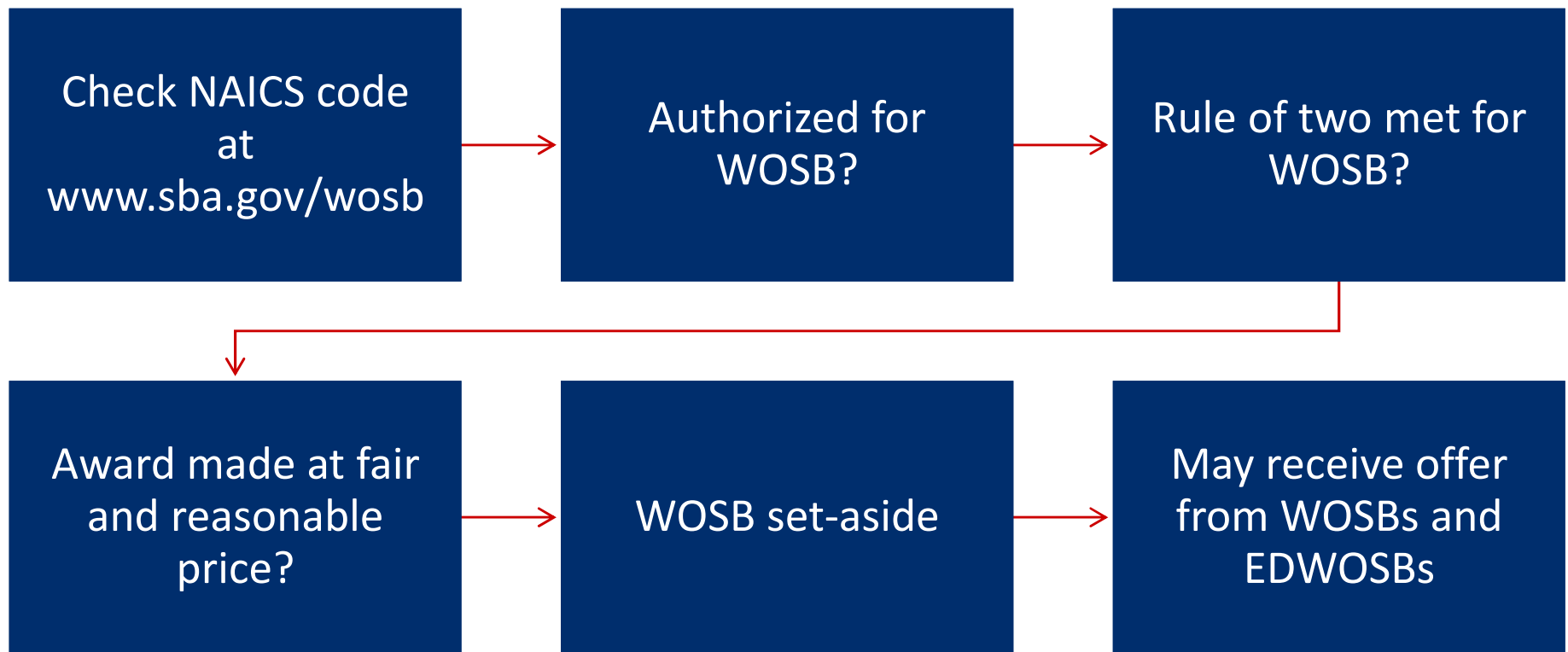

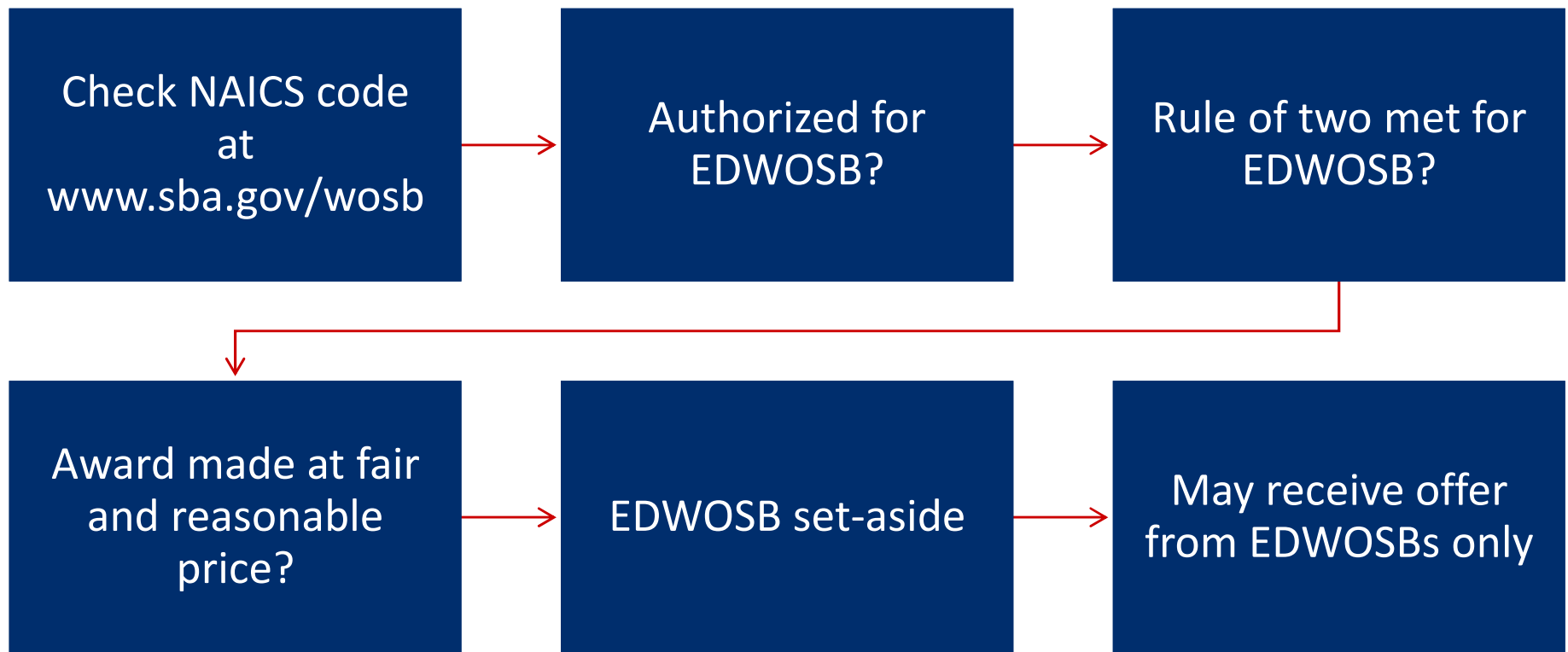

# Important WOSB Considerations

- **Suggested language to include in a WOSB/EDWOSB solicitation:**

" Pursuant to FAR 19.1503(a), offerors must be sure their WOSB or EDWOSB status is in accordance with 13 CFR Part 127.

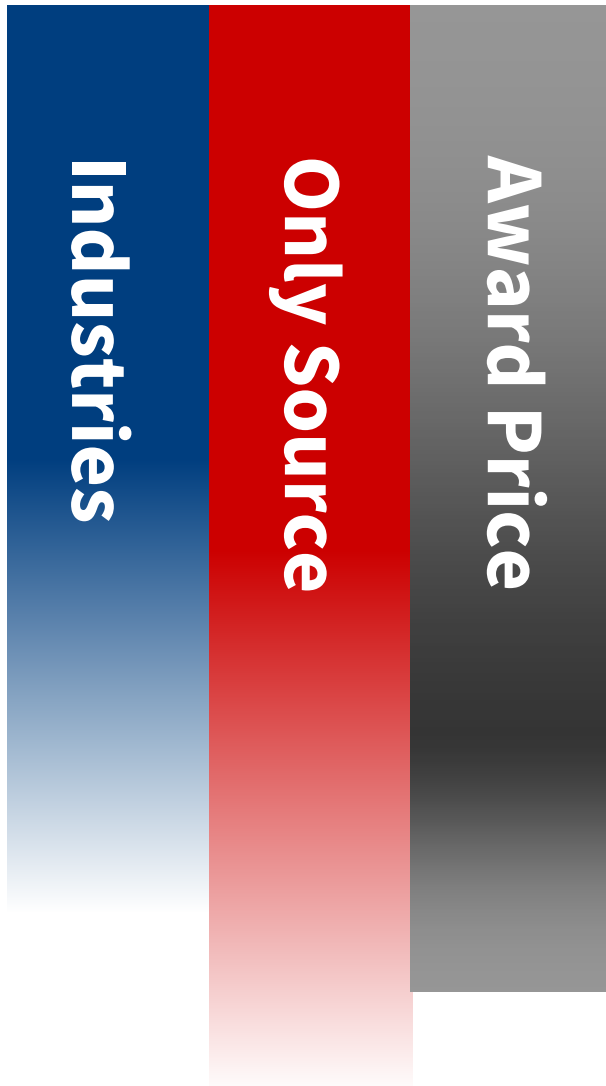
If the apparent successful offeror has submitted a complete application that is pending certification at the time of initial offer, or certified, by the U.S. Small Business Administration (SBA), the offeror will be eligible for proposal or bid submission, per 13 CFR 127.504. Offerors that need assistance in submitting a complete application to [WOSB.Certify.sba.gov](http://WOSB.Certify.sba.gov) are advised to contact the SBA Office of Government Contracting at [wosb@sba.gov](mailto:wosb@sba.gov)."

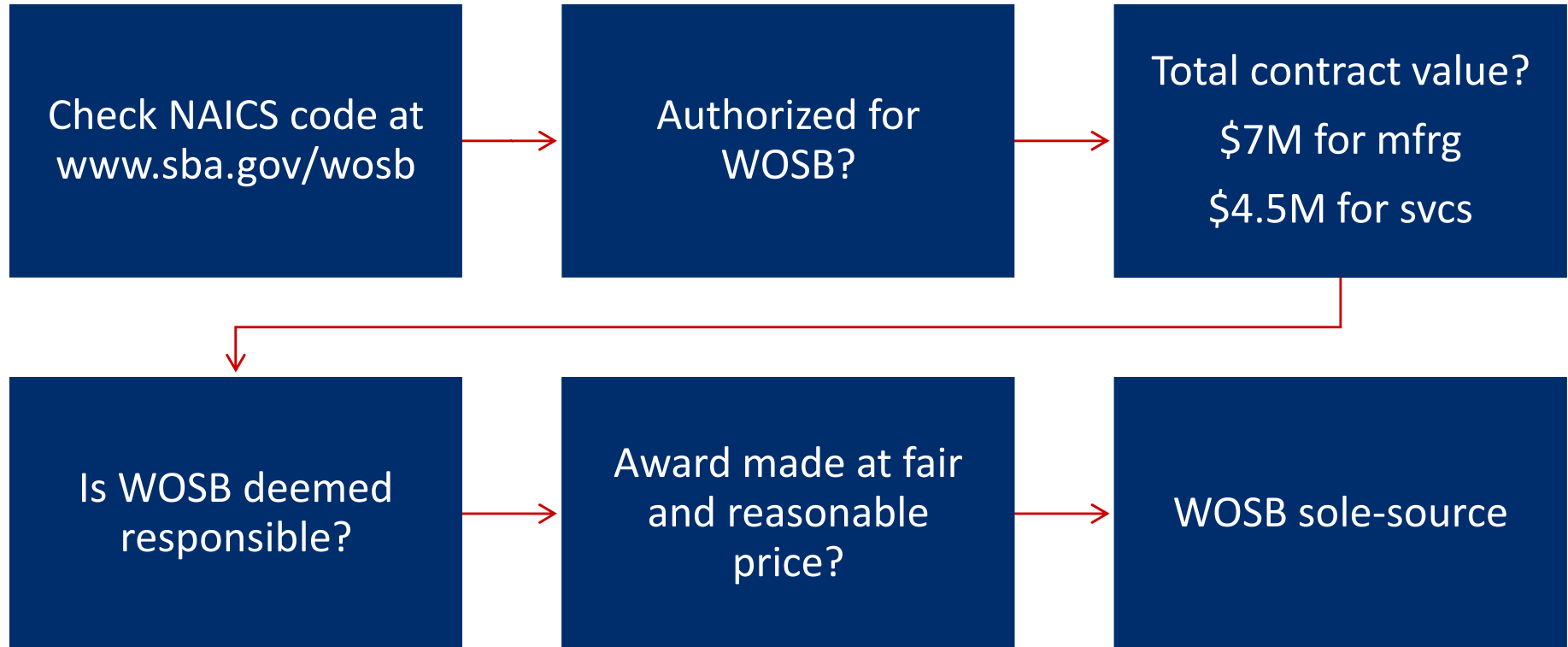

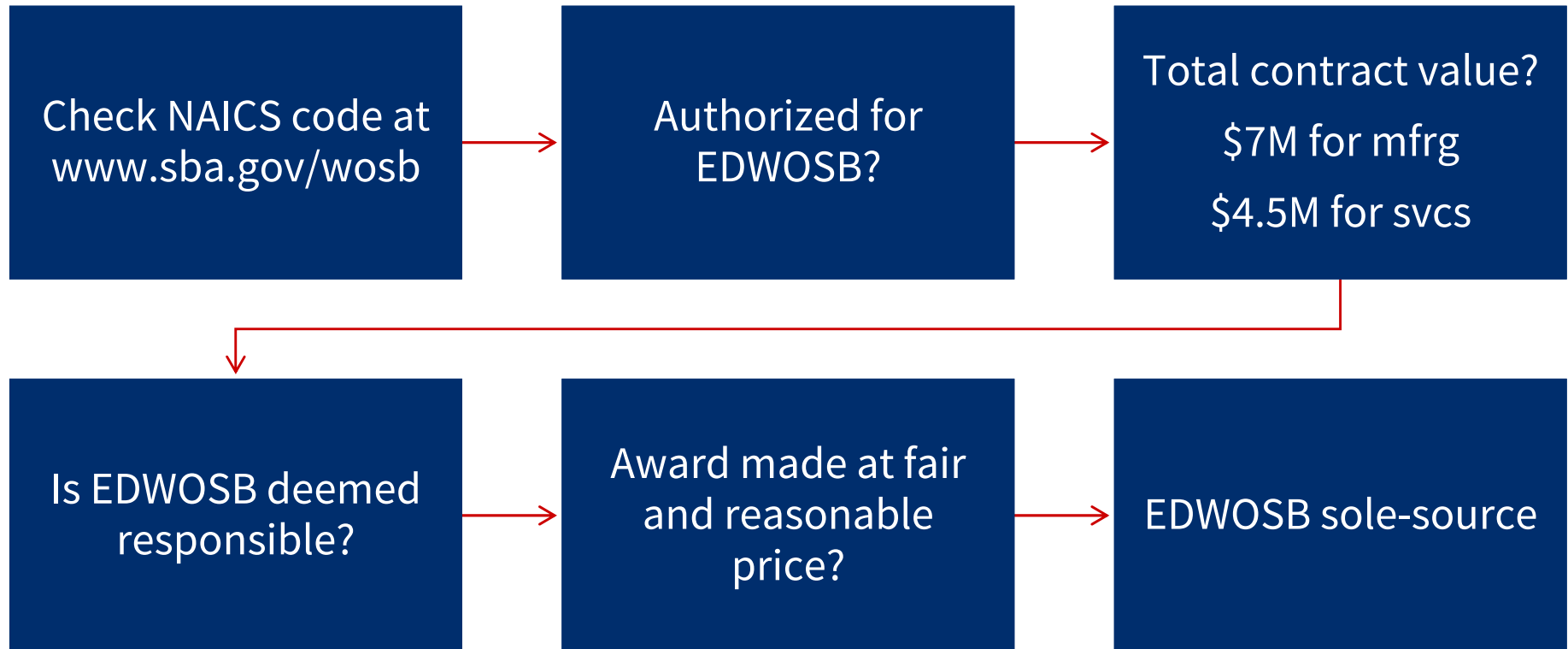

## FAR 6.302-5(b)(7)

- Establishes sole-source authority under the WOSB Federal Contract Program.

## FAR 6.302-5(c)(2)

- Provides contracts awarded using this authority shall be supported by written J&As.

# Joint Ventures

A WOSB/EDWOSB may submit an offer as a **joint venture** with another small business if the requirements of 13 CFR 127.506 are met.

**Note:** JV agreement must be submitted to CO.  
SBA does **not** approve JV agreement but will process any status protests!

## Eligibility Examinations & Protests

SBA is committed to ensuring only eligible WOSBs benefit from the WOSB Federal Contract Program. FAR guidance for protests for SBA Programs: FAR 19.3

Any WOSB/EDWOSB found to be ineligible will be decertified in DSBS; CO ***shall not award*** the contract.





## Changes to Remember

- The self-certification process is no longer available in [certify.sba.gov](https://certify.sba.gov). All Firms seeking to participate in the program must apply via [WOSB.Certify.sba.gov](https://WOSB.Certify.sba.gov)
- Third-party certified firms **MUST** submit their TPC certificate to [WOSB.Certify.sba.gov](https://WOSB.Certify.sba.gov) for SBA to display their WOSB certification.
- **All firms** seeking to participate in the WOSB Federal Contract Program, WOSB or EDWOSB set-aside contract or sole source must be **certified**.
- Verification of a firm's WOSB Certification can be viewed on the firm's [Dynamic Small Business Search \(DSBS\)](#) profile under Federal Certifications section.
